Land Use and Development Law

On September 6, 2011, Chief and Council of the Tsleil-Waututh Nation passed a Band Council Resolution authorizing the preparation of a Land Use and Development Law in accordance to the provisions in the Land Code. The law will govern the land development approval process for developments on Tsleil-Waututh lands.

The law may included provisions for:

1. The promotion of health, safety, convenience and welfare of the members of the Band, residents and occupants and other persons who have a lawful interest in lands with the Reserve;
2. The prevention of overcrowding on the Reserve lands, the preservation of the natural and heritage assets, and the protection of the traditional life style of the Band;
3. The protection of the Environment;
4. The impact of the development on the financial well-being of the Band;
5. The economic benefit of the development to the Band in terms of employment opportunities for the Band members, taxes, and other spin-offs benefits;
6. The security of adequate light and reasonable access; and
7. The quality of design & construction.
